The lifetime commitment that sets us apart

Sometimes a dog comes along and steals your heart away in one fell swoop. You know the kind: long flowy ears, completely helpless, sweet from the tip of their snout to the end of their nubby tail. Ronnie's smile fills the room. He is a gentle and kind soul, the sort of fellow you cannot help but love. His story is one of loss and perseverance. And it is one we love to share.

Ronnie was transferred to HSAR from Lassen County Animal Control in 2018. Not long after, he was adopted into a loving home. Sadly, after four years together, his owner passed away. Their family could not keep up with

Ronnie's daily care and the financial cost of ownership. Ronnie had developed Diabetes and Glaucoma. He needed insulin twice a day, eye drops, and a specific diet plan.

We have a lifetime commitment to the dogs adopted out through our rescue and we welcomed Ronnie back with open arms in February. Before the search for his forever family could begin, we had to get his health on track. Our boy took each visit to Reno in stride, winning over the hearts of everyone he met in the veterinary office. With a few adjustments to his diet and insulin dosage, Ronnie began to show improvement in energy and spirit. He spent his days in the front office, basking in the attention of staff and visitors. Though he was happy, we could see his time at HSAR wearing on him.

After six months, it became clear to one of our Administrative Assistants, Lisa, that Ronnie needed a home sooner rather than later. Lisa introduced Ronnie to their pack of three cattle dogs with complete success and they've all become close friends. He has adjusted to life so well, accompanying his new crew to Lake Davis nearly everyday.

Despite only having one eye now, he is able to dip his toes in the cool water and enjoy time with his incredible forever family.

All of us at HSAR are so grateful for Lisa and her husband Charlie for giving this sweet dog the home he deserves. We are also so thankful for our supporters who have made it possible for us to care for Ronnie since his return. He is proof that through compassion and dedication all dogs can find the forever homes they deserve.

Ronnie's costs for HSAR are ongoing. His recent eye removal surgery and follow up appointments have totaled \$5,000. There are also monthly expenses for prescription food and insulin. Please consider a one time or monthly donation to HSAR to help us provide for our dear friend, Ronnie.



Their future is in your hands


